The WPCC is a local charity which supports families across the county, all of whom have a child with a disability or additional need.

The WPCC's main aim is to bring families out of isolation, ensuring that they are able to enjoy quality time together within their community, with other families.

The 14+ project is designed to give 14 to 19 year olds with additional needs more freedom. Young people can attend the sessions without parents needing to attend, as we have support workers at all events.

We run one activity per month, normally on a Saturday 2—4 pm at Pershore Riverside Centre, King Georges Way, Pershore, WR10 1QU. Once a quarter this will be a day out, with monthly youth clubs in between.

The young people can take part in organised activities such as, Cooking, Art and Craft, Paddle Boarding, Husky Sledging and much more.

For a young person to attend a 14+ event, their family must be members of WPCC (it is free to register).
