

National Professional Qualification for Middle Leadership (NPQML) - Specialist Leadership

The National Professional Qualification for Middle Leadership (NPQML) is a qualification that provides national recognition of your leadership development and professional achievement as a middle leader leading a team.

The specialist leadership course focusses on aspiring and current middle leaders who are working with children and young people who have special educational needs and/or disability.

Who can apply?

You should be a current or aspiring middle leader in a school with the responsibility of leading a team and interested in finding out more about the best way to do so, or those with this as their goal, For example: key stage leader; curriculum area leader; pastoral services leader; subject leader; head of department.

Programme outline – 'Leading a Team'

The NPQML programme typically takes up to one year to complete, during which time participants will complete six areas of study:


- Working in partnership
- Managing resources and risk
- Strategy and improvement
- Teaching and curriculum excellence
- Increasing capacity
- Leading with impact

In addition to the six areas of study, there are also seven leadership behaviours which set out how a leader should operate on a daily basis. These are:

- Commitment
- Collaboration
- Personal drive
- Awareness

- Respect
- Resilience
- Integrity

Our NPQ programmes are designed around a blended learning approach which incorporates face to face days, online courses and collaborative study.

The NPQML programme takes up to one year to complete.

To achieve the qualification you will need to successfully complete the six areas of study.

Assessment:

- Completion of all the online courses
- Attendance at all face to face days
- Final assessment of a school improvement project against the criteria for the award of the qualification
