We are once again running our Saturday Family Swims and are taking bookings for swim sessions starting Saturday 11th January 2020 to Saturday 28th March 2020 inclusive.

The cost of swims is £10.00. This cost does not include any assistance in the pool or changing area. A poolside attendant will be present throughout your swim. In order for you to use the correct sling it is advisable for you to bring your own wet sling.

Session times will run in hourly slots to allow half an hour swim with 15 minutes change time before and after, and will run from 9:00am until 1.00pm.

Pool Rules for Community & Family Swim Sessions

- 1. Sessions are open to adults and children with physical difficulties living in our local community, Saturday swims are currently available to past and present pupils of Chadsgrove School.
- 2. All sessions have 30 minutes pool time plus approximately 15 minutes changing time either side between the hours of 12:15 and 13:15 on Tuesdays and Thursdays and on a Saturday 9:00am to 1:00pm.
- 3. Plastic overshoes must be worn or shoes and socks removed before entering the poolside. Carers must ensure that wheelchair tyres are reasonable clean.
- 4. Entrance to the pool will be via the school reception for community swim, Saturday swims by pool side entrance.
- 5. There will always be a member of Chadsgrove staff on pool side and/or a lifeguard with the RLSS National Pool Lifeguard Qualification for family swims.
- 6. A maximum of 3 spectators per family is allowed on the poolside on the basis that they will wear over shoes or remove footwear.
- 7. Absolutely no running, pushing or chasing in the changing rooms or surrounding area. Diving or jumping into the pool will not be allowed under any circumstances.
- 8. No food or drinks, other than water in plastic bottles etc. are allowed at any time in any areas of the pool or changing rooms.
- 9. Whilst the school will always make every effort to maintain the quality of the pool water at all times, all pool users do so entirely at their own risk.
- 10. Should there be a minor personal medical incident or similar in the pool (e.g. vomit/faeces) the pool will be evacuated and closed for at least 48 hours.
- 11. Swimmers and carers are asked to leave the pool areas in a clean and tidy condition.
- 12. Should a serious emergency occur in the pool then an ambulance should be summoned by telephoning the emergency services. (A phone is installed in the changing room, by the first changing bed dial 9 then 999 to summon help).
- 13. In the highly unlikely event of the fire bell sounding in the pool areas, families should meet outside the fire exit wrapped in towel etc. to keep warm. The lifeguard must phone the emergency services after ensuring the pool area and the changing rooms have been evacuated.
- 14. Families should take the time to read the Normal Operating Procedures (NOP) and Emergency Action Plan (EAP) that is placed on the side of the pool. The lifeguard will be fully conversed in this.
- 15. Swimmers must book in advance to use the pool. Charges of £5.00 per session £10.00 Saturdays paid in either cash or cheque made payable to "Worcestershire County Council".
- 16. Bookings must be cancelled by Monday prior to the sessions. No refund will be sanctioned unless the pool is closed by the school.
- 17. The Head Teacher or Governors reserve the right to terminate pool sessions for any person they feel is in breach of these rules for any reason they feel to be justified.
- 18. Families will be required to sign a document confirming they have read and understood this list of rules and that they agree to abide by them at all times.
- 19. If the pool falls below 32 degrees then the pool will be automatically closed.
