



Statement of Behaviour Principles

1. Every pupil understands that they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected and to learn in an environment that is free from disruption from others.
2. All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
3. Staff, Governors and volunteers set and excellent example to pupils at all times
4. Rewards are used consistently by staff in line with the school behaviour policy and sanctions are applied where necessary
5. The behaviour policy is understood by pupils and staff
6. The exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort and outlines the processes involved in permanent and fixed-term exclusions
7. Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions
8. When behaviour incidents do occur these are addressed in partnership with families to foster positive behaviour for all pupils
9. Physical intervention/reasonable force is used only as a last resort to maintain the safety and welfare of pupils
10. This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the Governing Body annually.
