

Statement of Behaviour Principles

- Every pupil understands that they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected and to learn in an environment that is free from disruption from others.
- 2. All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- 3. Staff, Governors and volunteers set and excellent example to pupils at all times
- 4. Rewards are used consistently by staff in line with the school behaviour policy and sanctions are applied where necessary
- 5. The behaviour policy is understood by pupils and staff
- 6. The exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort and outlines the processes involved in permanent and fixed-term exclusions
- 7. Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions
- 8. When behaviour incidents do occur these are addressed in partnership with families to foster positive behaviour for all pupils
- 9. Physical intervention/reasonable force is used only as a last resort to maintain the safety and welfare of pupils
- 10. This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the Governing Body annually.
