Caesee in the garden in the sunshine. Caesee was so pleased with her PE kit from school that she fell asleep with it.





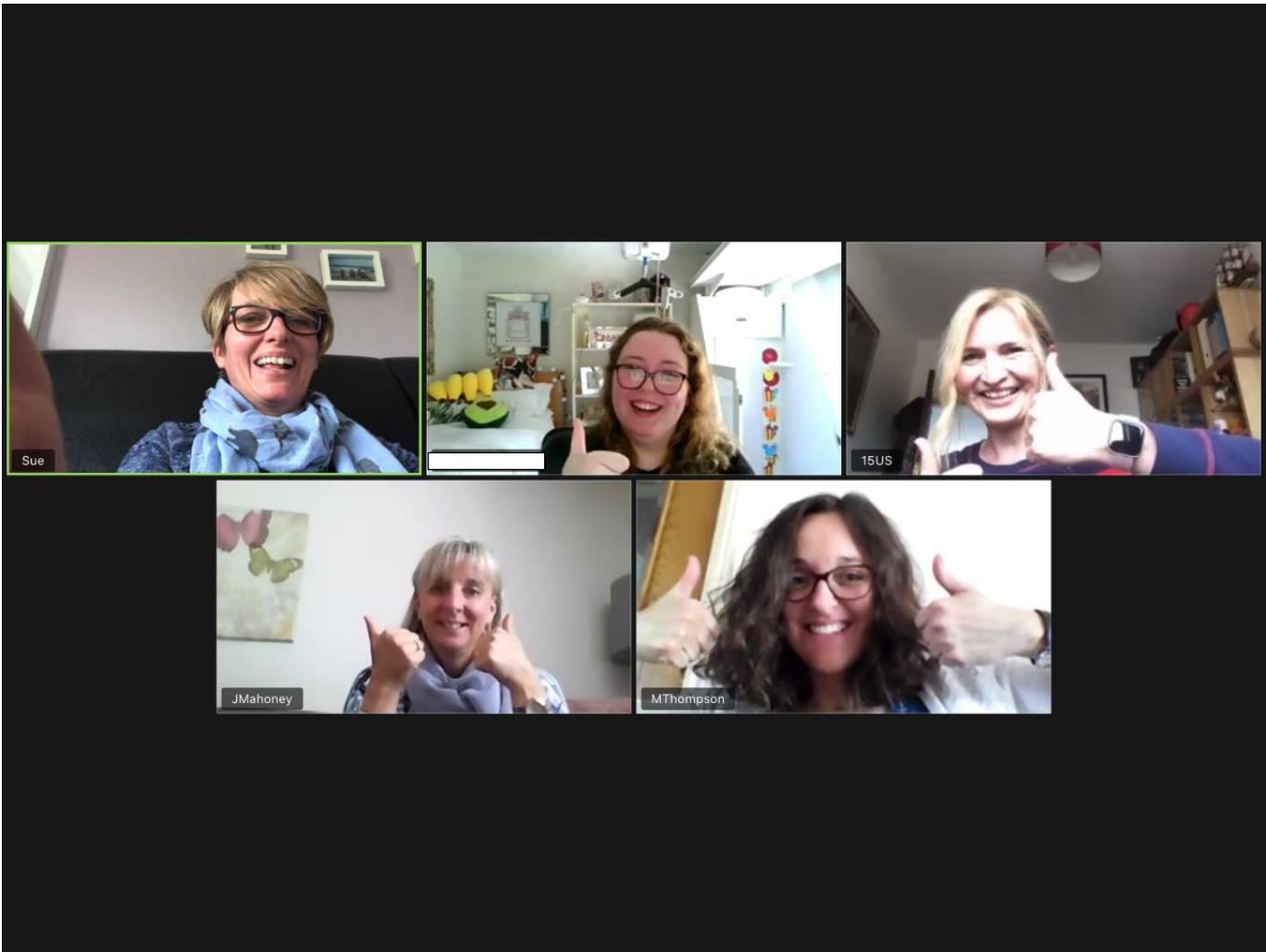
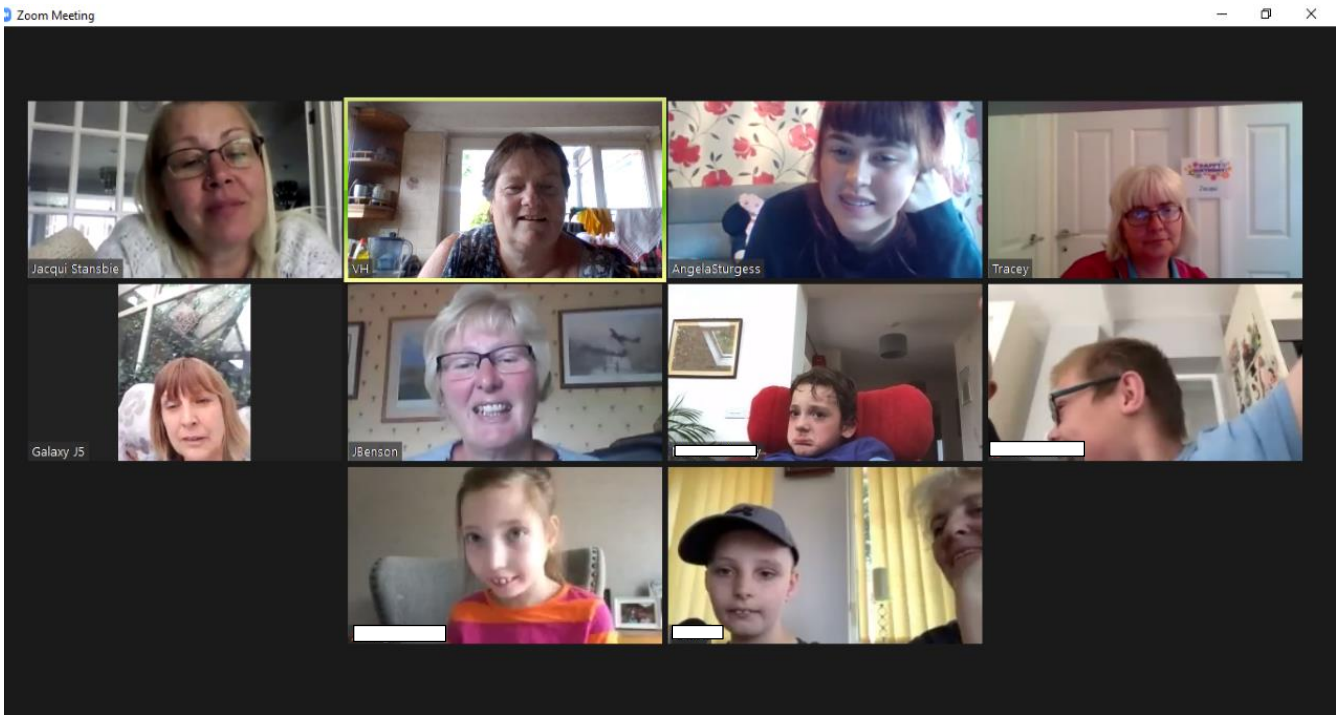
Indiana has been enjoying the sunny weather and going on family walks. We have been so lucky with the weather Indiana.



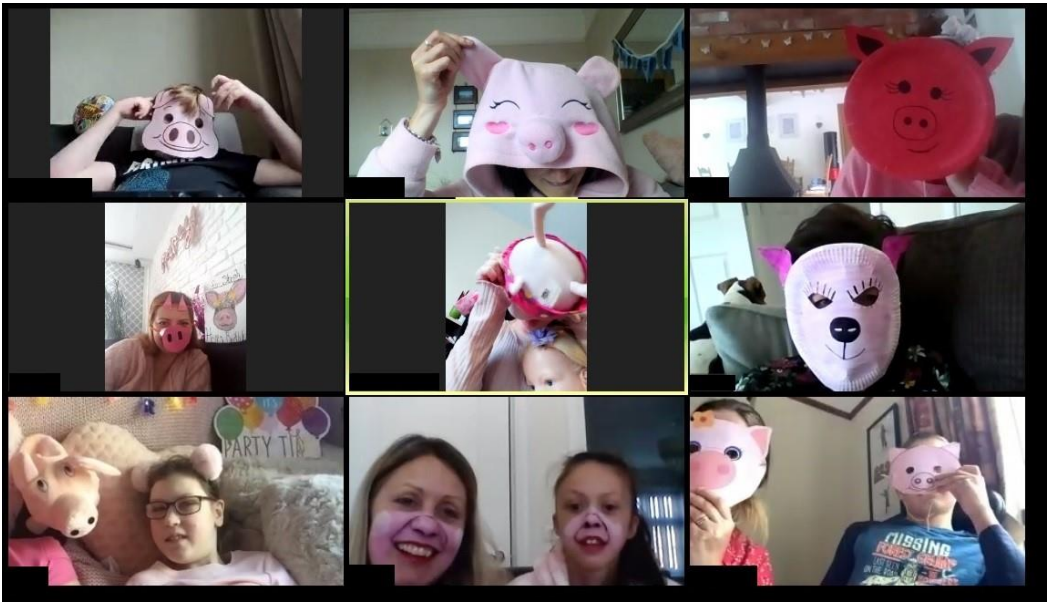


Ania has been enjoying colouring in her garden and learning about European Countries with her Dad. Well done Ania on keeping up with learning during lockdown.

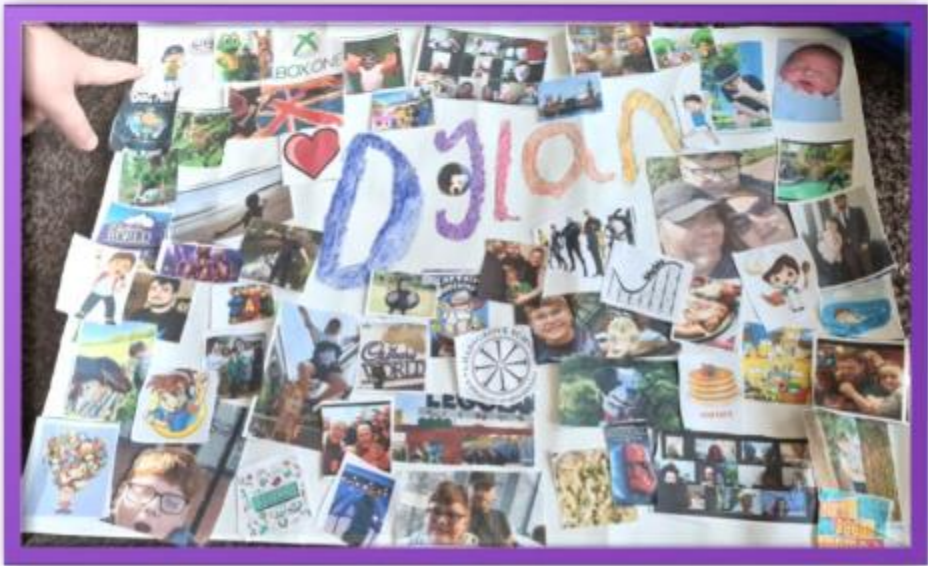
Tom H and his brother playing trampoline catch (an advanced skill). Tom earned 5 House points for this Catching Challenge.
