








Yousuf enjoying some pyjamas time. That looks a very tricky piece of construction Yousuf.






Arez has been busy celebrating Eid. We hope you had a lovely time Arez.

## SCIENTISTS OF THE WEEK


6LS were busy impressing us in the last issue of the Chronicle...This week it's all over to 14US (and there are more 14US science superstars to come next week too!)

**WORCESTERSHIRE VIRTUAL SCHOOL GAMES**

**TARGET PRIMARY SCHOOL CHALLENGE HIT THE MARK: 8 - 12TH JUNE 2020**

This competition is a test of accuracy, concentration and hand eye coordination!

- You will need a line marker (socks, pags, tins etc.), hoops as your target (made from tea towels or towels) and bean bags (socks).
- If you are in Year 3, 4, 5 or 6, you will also need a bucket!
- The object is to throw the items while standing behind the line at the numbered targets. Keep tally of your points with each successful hit and once all throws have been made, record your total score.

**Primary Challenge:**

- If you are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, you have 3 objects to throw.
- Aim throw 1 at target 1 (1 point if you hit the mark), throw 2 at target 2 (2 points if you hit the mark) and throw 3 at target 3 (3 points if you hit the mark).
- Repeat this twice more (9 throws in total). Add your points together from the 9 throws for your final score.
- Years 3, 4, 5 & 6, you have 4 objects to throw. As above, but if you get it in the bucket you get 5 points
- Record your first attempt and your best attempt!
