

Speech & Language Therapy Services

The ability to communicate is an essential life skill for all children and young people and it underpins a child's social, emotional and educational development. Strong language and communication skills are linked to better outcomes for children and young people in school and beyond.

10% of all children have long term or persistent speech language and communication needs (SLCN) – the most prevalent special educational need identified by primary schools. The Children's Speech and Language therapy Service is commissioned by the NHS and Worcestershire County Council to deliver services at a targeted and specialist level to children attending mainstream schools, working in partnership with the wider workforce to meet children's needs. Additional services from direct therapy to whole setting/school training and everything in between are available to be commissioned by schools to enhance their core service. Some aspects of this are now available through Chadsgrove School Support Team.

Example Interventions	Units
Individual assessment & written report	8 units
Programme of individual intervention, delivered by the therapist and support given to school staff	12 units per 6 session programme
Programme of group intervention, delivered by the therapist and support given to school staff	12 units per 6 session programme
Whole school audit and report including recommendations	Individually calculated (24 unit minimum for a one form entry)
Whole school training – full-day	24 units
Whole school training – half-day	12 units
Whole school training – 2hr twilight	8 units
