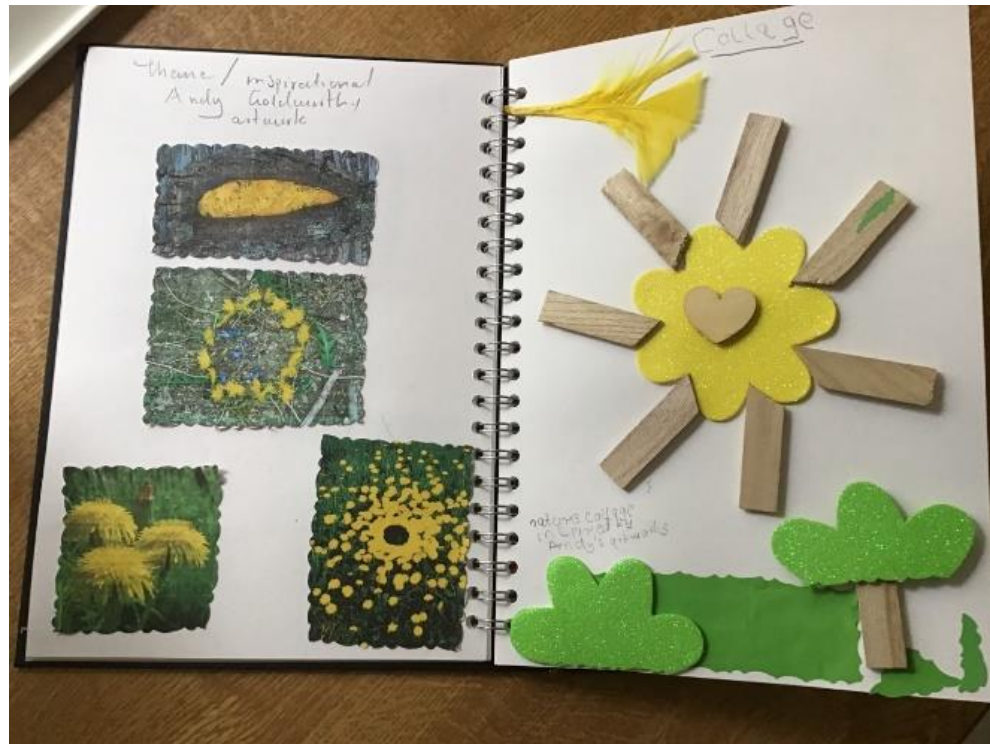


Research and experiment...

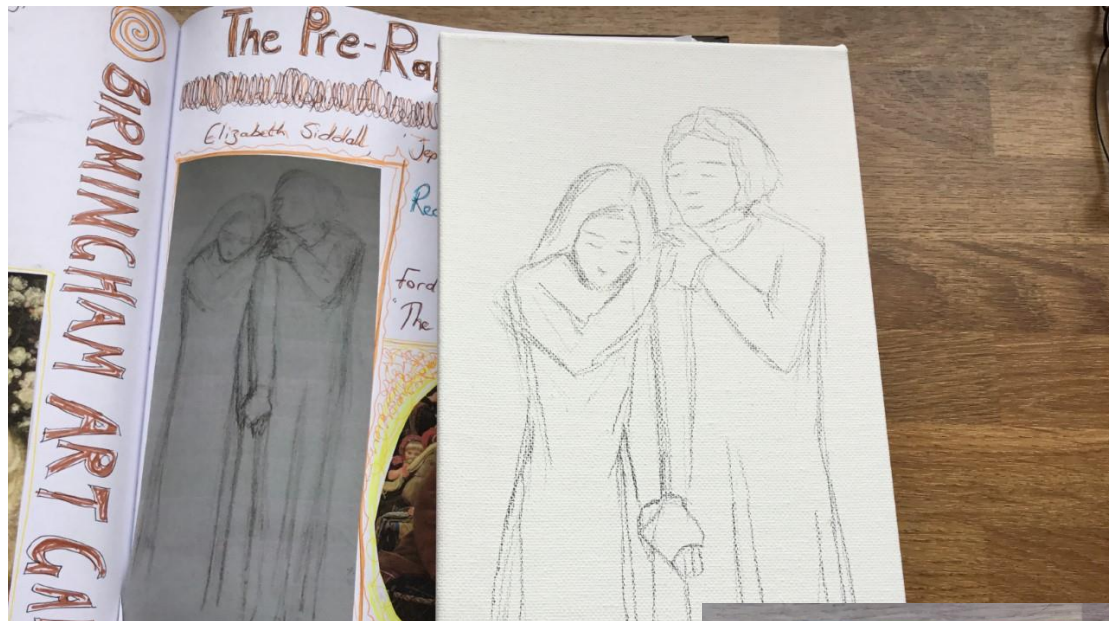
