Planting Sunflowers for 13us



Equipment needed



- Plant pot or kitchen roll tube
- Compost
- Labels and pen/pencil
- Trowel
- Dibber
- Seeds
- Tamper
- Watering can/hose
- Garden gloves



If you are using Kitchen roll tube you will need to cut it in half so you have two. Then you will need to cut four 3cm cuts at the bottom then fold them in. As shown in photos. If using pots you need to make sure they are clean as they could have bacteria in them that could harm the plants. I did microwave the kitchen roll tubes before using them.



Fill pots/rolls with compost. Level of with tamper. Then gently press down compost with tamper, not too hard else the roots and water will have no where to grow or go. If you haven't got a tamper I used another pot. You need a little room at top of pot so the water doesn't wash away the compost, when watering.



Make hole in the middle of the compost with the dibber. Again if you haven't got one you can use a wooden stick or pencil. Put your sunflower seed in hole and cover over with surrounding compost.



Then you need to label and water. Then wait for them to grow.
