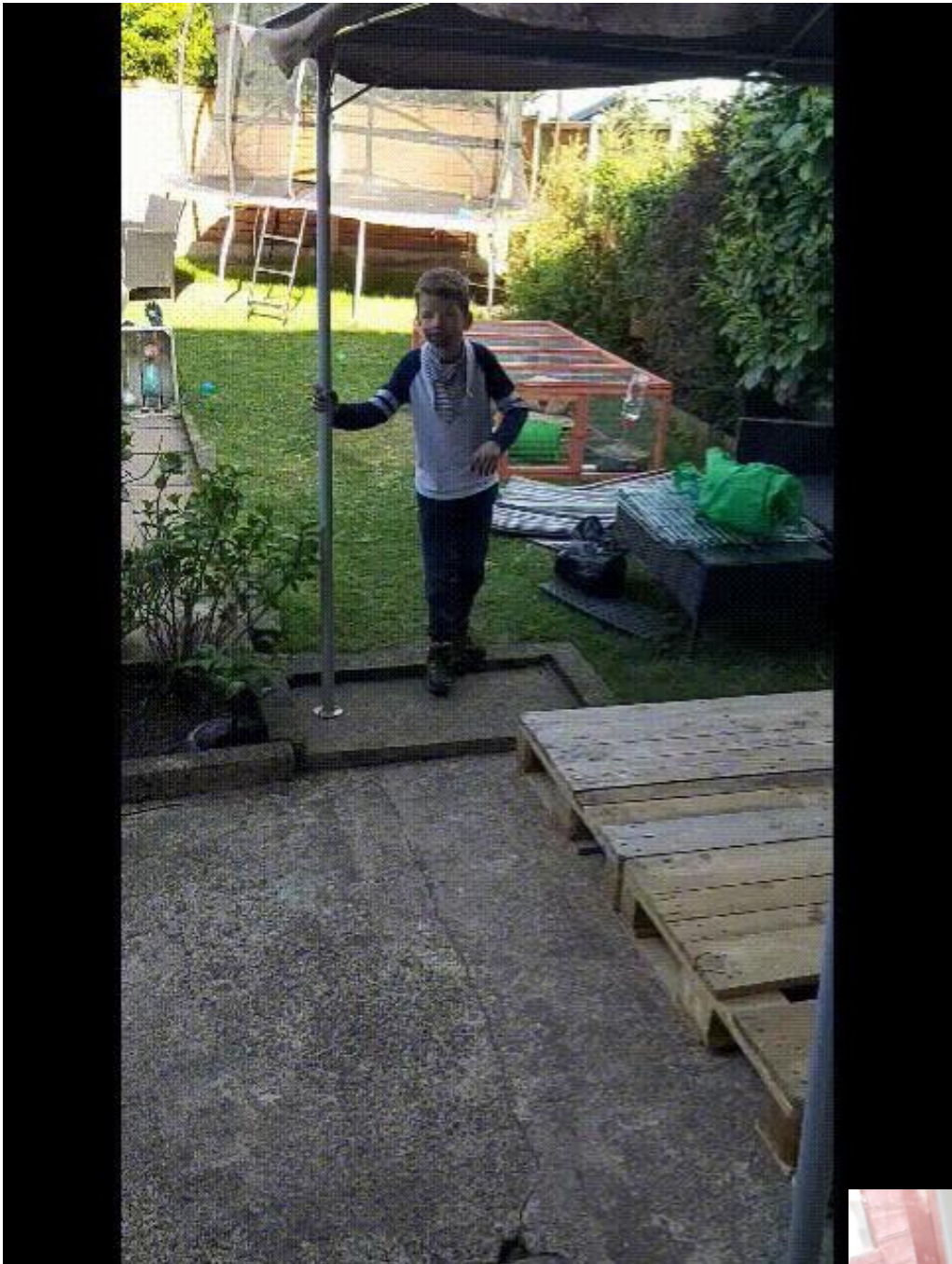

We think you were rumbled.....



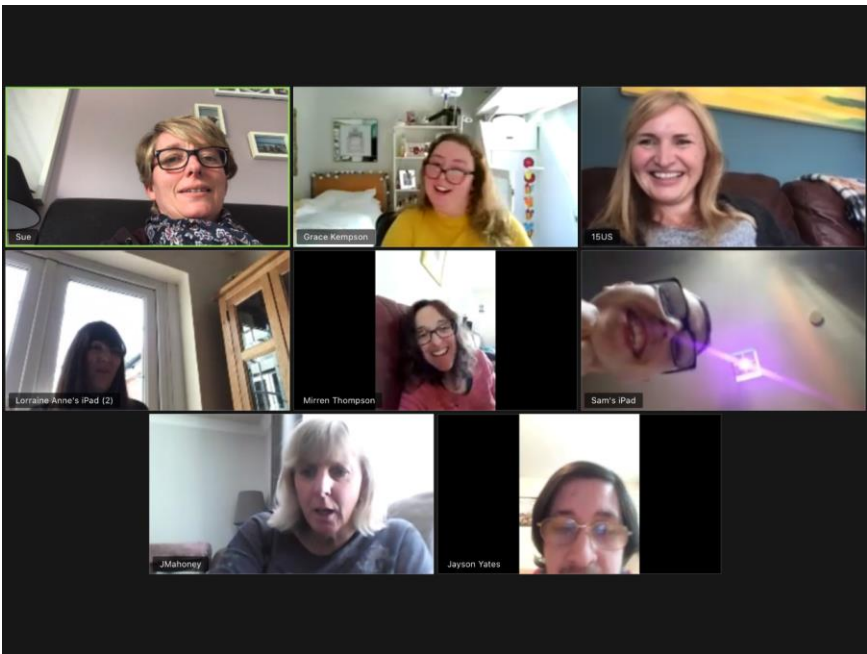

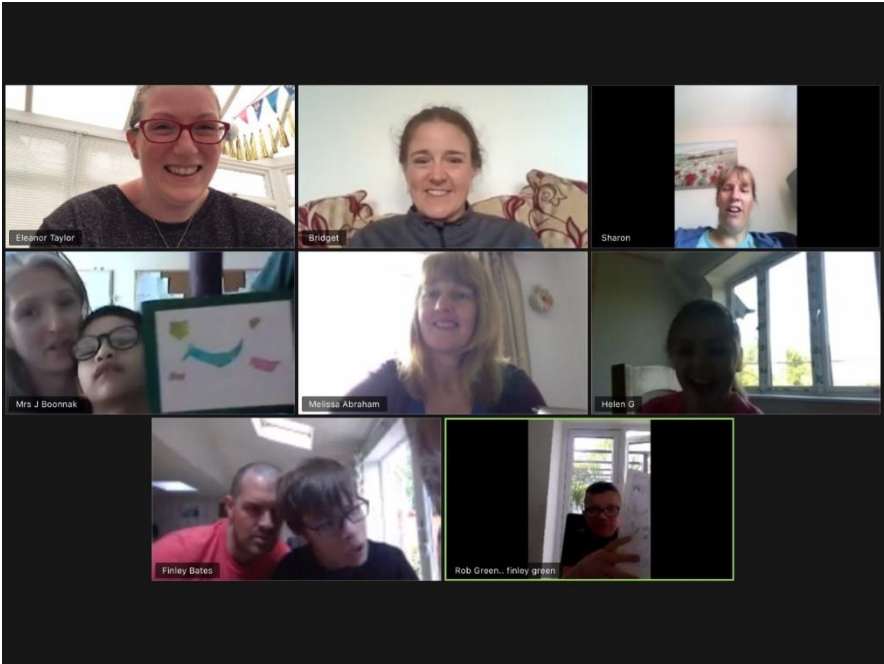

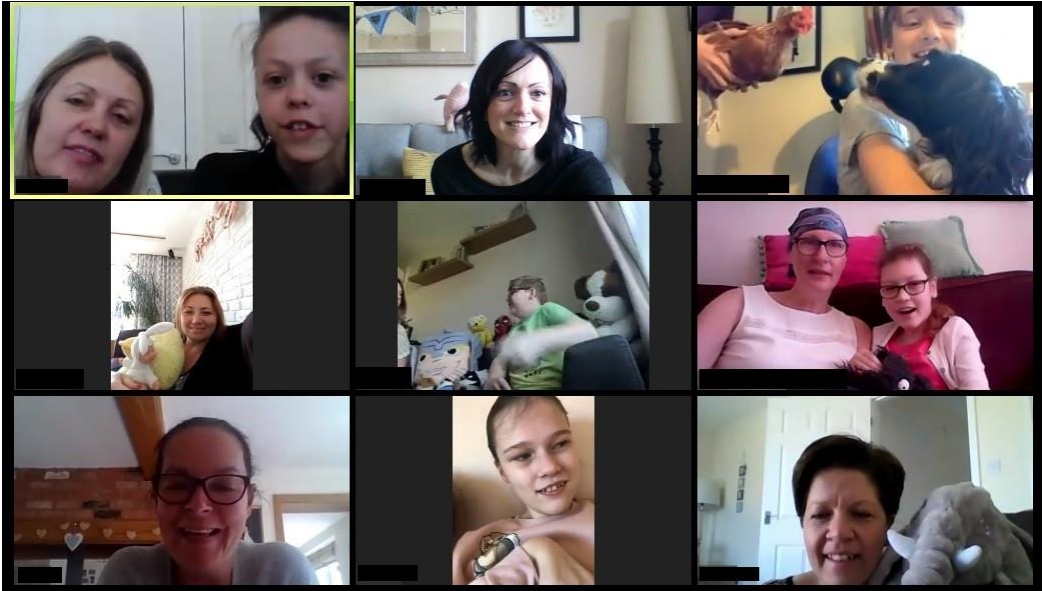

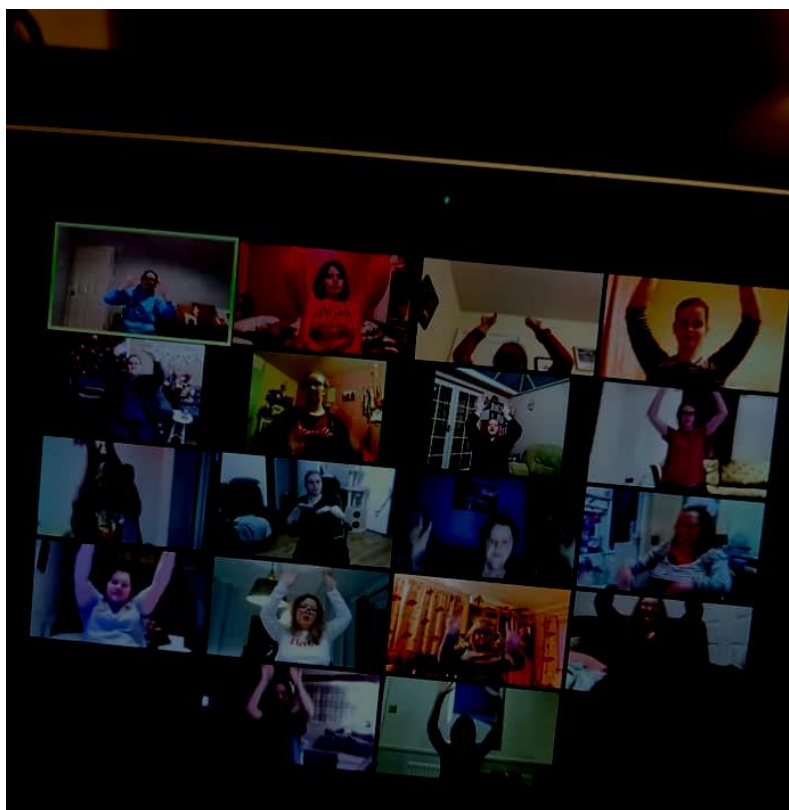
This is Freewheelin we are an inclusive dance group we meet weekly, (Friday nights!).
