
Jessica has been baking over half term, she made some lovely cookies. We bet they were delicious! Move over Jamie Oliver!

Holly has been having a great time playing bingo with her sister's and won twice, Go Holly! Fern loves bingo too. Did you shout "Bingo!"








Kyle has also been chilling in his "new" home chair!




Kyle is looking very proud of himself after all his painting, he decided it was "selfie" time and took a lovely photo of himself.


Look how cool Mason's hair looks! We really like it. Kyle has also had a new hairstyle too! All we need now is one of your massive handsome smiles. Cheeese!





Tim has been very busy at home this week, learning lots of new skills. Our regular handyman has decided to help out by loading the washing


machine. We hope you sorted out your "darks" and "lights!" Good work Tim! What's the next thing you would like to learn? We could all use some help around our houses!
