

People Who Help Us: Lollypop Person



Lollypop men and ladies help us cross the road.

They usually are found outside schools to help children cross the road safely.

They have a big round sign post with the words STOP which they show to the traffic.

We must wait on the pavement until they tell us that it is safe to cross the road.



Sometimes they stand on zebra crossings.



Stop, Look, Listen

Stop, look and listen,
Before you cross the street.

Use your eyes, use your ears,

It's important that when we are crossing the road that we STOP, LOOK and LISTEN .

If you're able to go on a walk, see if you can find a zebra crossing or traffic lights with a pedestrian crossing.

We can practice our colours: Red - STOP, Amber/orange GET READY and Green- GO

Let's listen to what we can hear when we are out- cars, lorries, birds singing, dogs barking. What did you hear on your walk?

You could decorate biscuits to look like traffic lights or make a giant traffic light game to practice throwing bean bags or use it as a colour sorting game.
