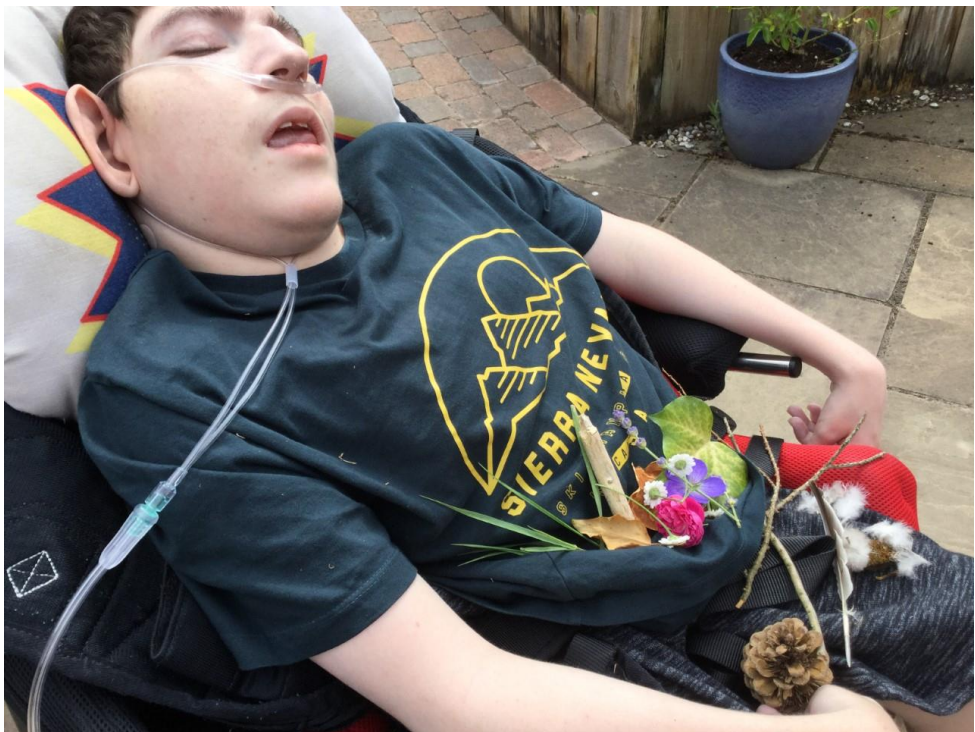

Heaven-Leigh had a lockdown birthday. Your cake looks lovely Heaven-Leigh. We hope you got lots of lovely presents too.

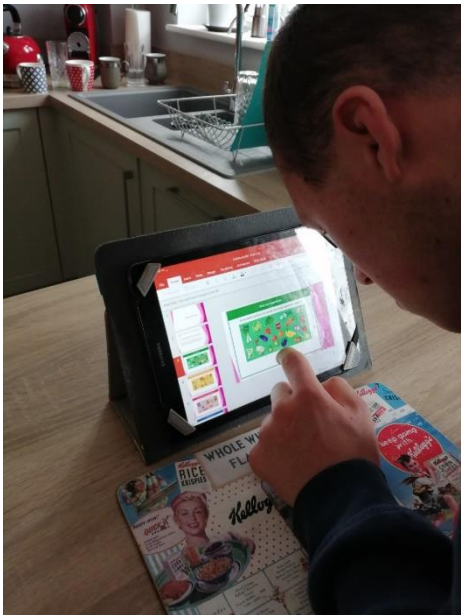


Thea saw a deer in her garden one evening. Thea loved it.
